Dear friends,

I wanted to send a short note to tell you that I am thinking of all of you during this very unsettling time.

When I closed Compass Early Learning Center last week and sent all but two other staff members home for an undetermined amount of time and with a lot of loose ends, I was not sure what would happen next. The world around me felt like it had stopped or at least it got weird - three weeks ago if you told me I'd be hosting virtual meetings from my house (in my pajamas), with my dog barking or 8 month-old baby squawking in the background, I wouldn't have believed you.

But your support for MCUM didn't stop. Here is what you made happen:

- You funded Compass families who immediately found themselves paying more for childcare. While the majority of our families are temporarily working from home, off work, or have family members/friends who can care for their children during this crisis free of charge, 4 families requested and received support paying for independent childcare.
- You kept our food pantry running. Each day the pantry has been open, we have seen a steady flow of traffic. Each household was also able to receive toilet paper and soap. Food donations have continued to come in, and we will be able to submit a mass grocery order to restock the pantry next week, thanks to a relief grant from the Community Foundation.
- You paid our staff. For the past 2 weeks, all of our staff are being paid their typical rates of pay and not forfeiting their sick or paid time off hours. Believe me when I say we have the best staff. In addition to it being a good thing to do, paying our staff during this time makes sure their financial self-sufficiency is not jeopardized and it keeps them from becoming unemployed and potentially not returning to work here.

I am so overwhelmed by the generosity of our supporters and wish I could call each of you out by name - but that would make for a very long email. Please follow us on Facebook (@mcumorg) where we have been and will continue to give shout-outs.
